

12.0 COORDINATION WITH OTHER EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS STANDARDS

Coordination with other educational programs is the process Becker, Big Lake, Monticello, and St. Michael/Albertville districts use to provide special education within the context of all other educational programs. The school board in Becker, Big Lake, Monticello, and St. Michael/Albertville shall adopt a written plan to assure that the curriculum developed for use within the districts' schools establishes and maintains an inclusive educational program. An inclusive educational program is one that employs a curriculum that is developed and delivered so that students and staff gain an understanding and appreciation of:

- A. The cultural diversity of the United States.
- B. The historical and contemporary contributions of women and men to society.
- C. The historical and contemporary contributions to society by persons with disabilities.
